PrivatAir receives national recognition for extensive participation in support of the FAA Wings Aviation Safety Program

At the annual Bradley Flight Standards District Office (FSDO) Safety Fest on Saturday, May 17, 2003, FAA Principal Operations Inspector Max Schmitter presented PrivatAir with a Company Award as a certificate of recognition for 100% pilot participation in the Federal Aviation Administration Pilot Proficiency Award Program.
